

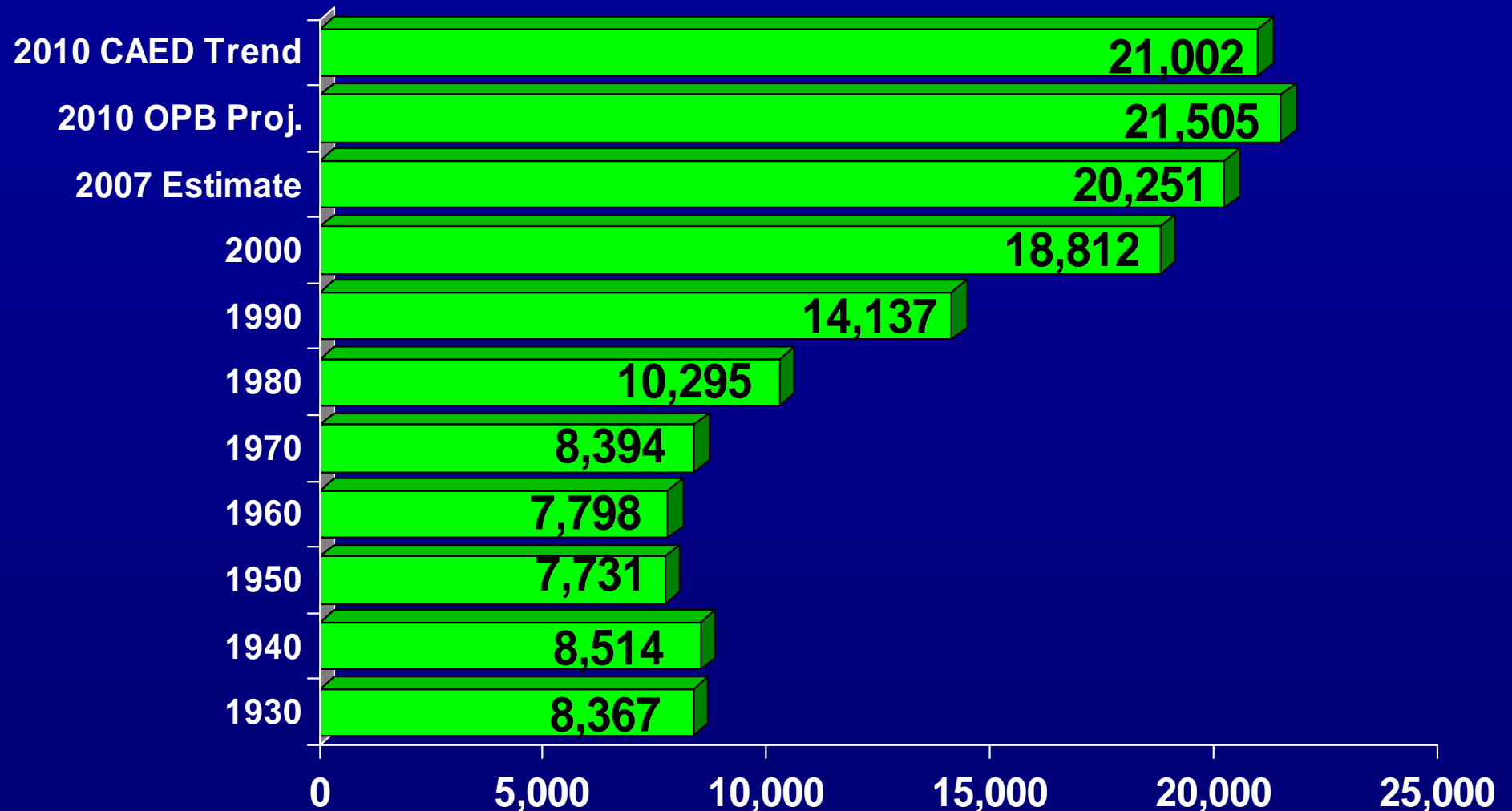

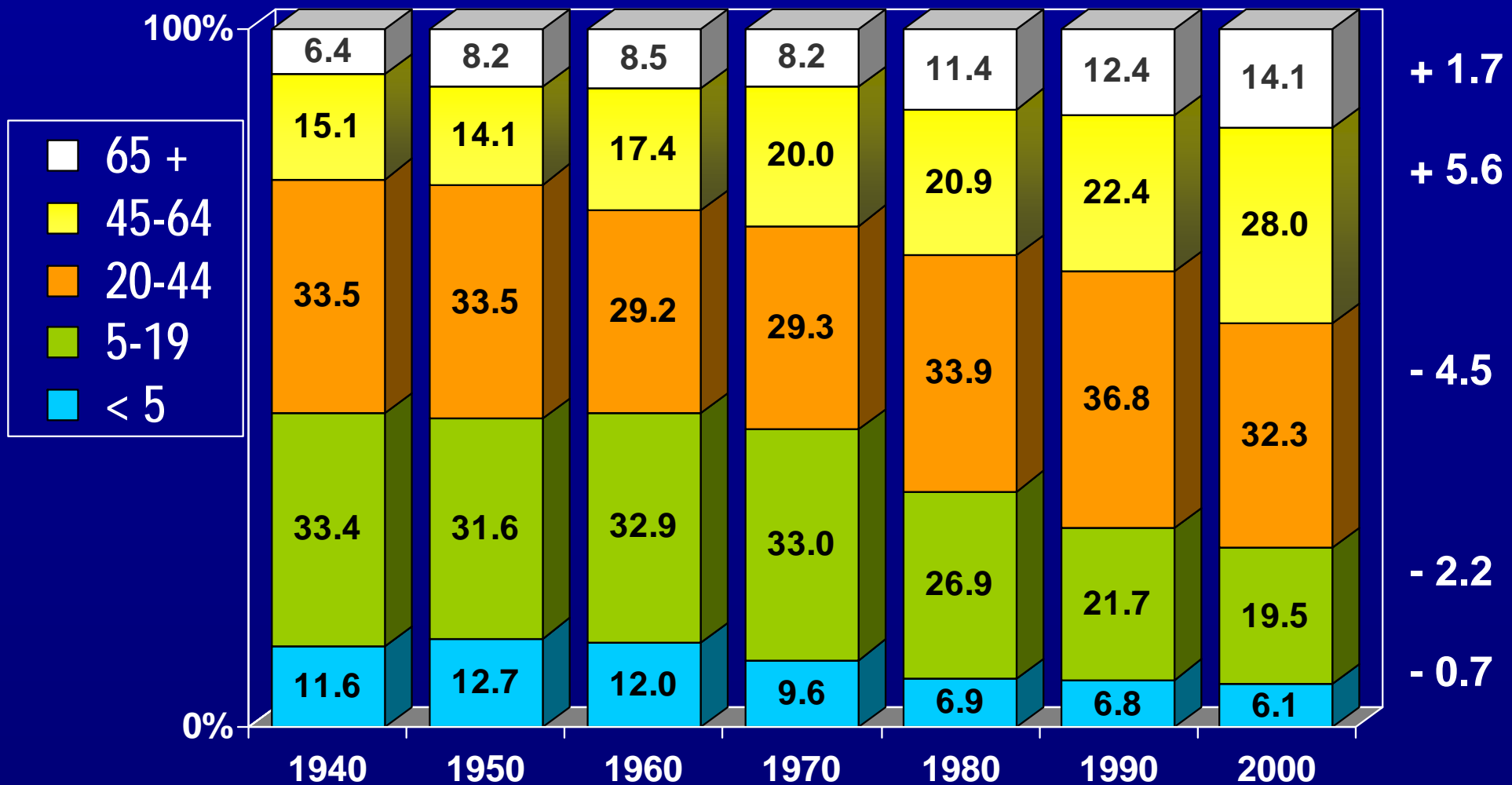
Total Population Putnam County

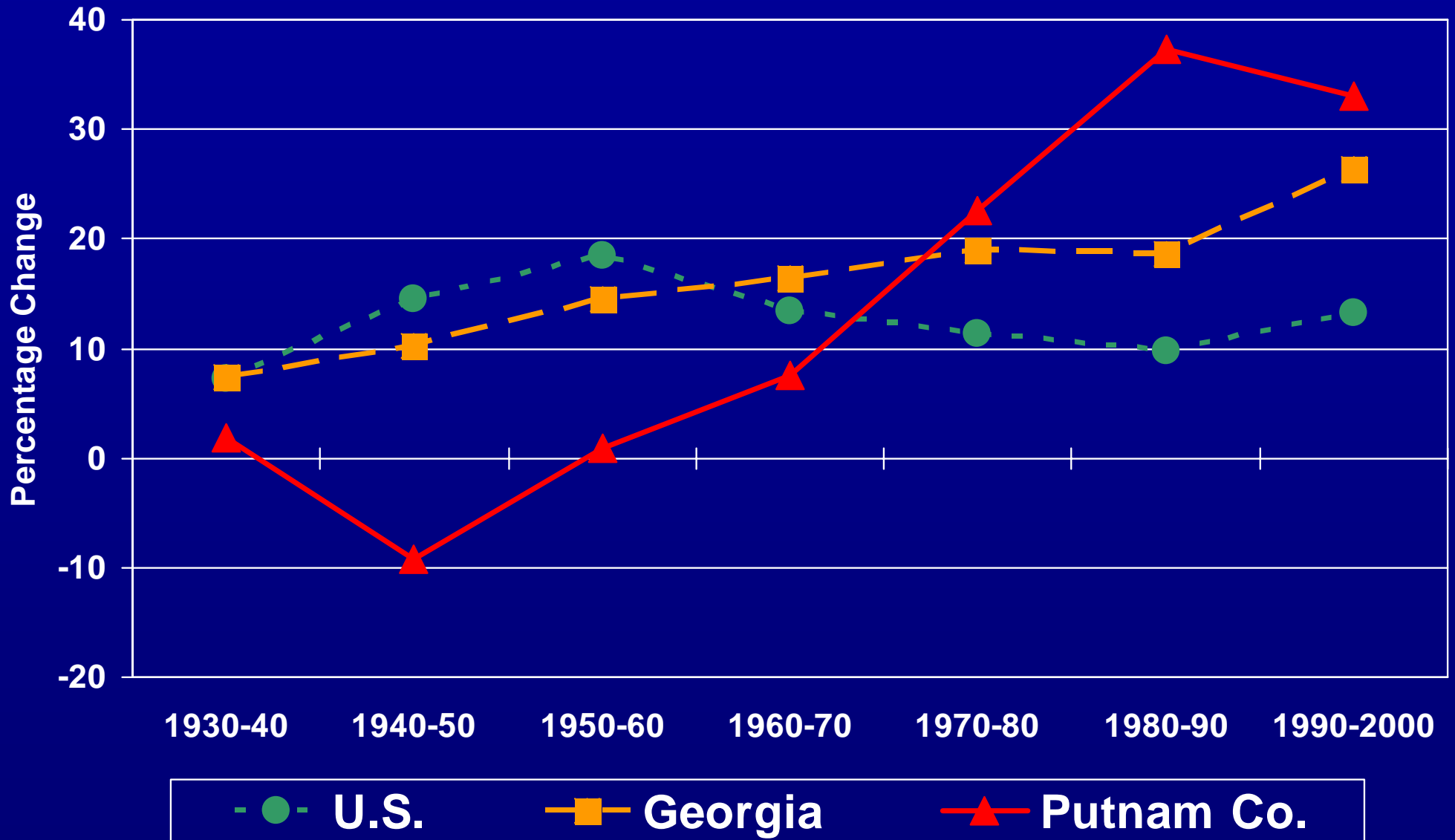

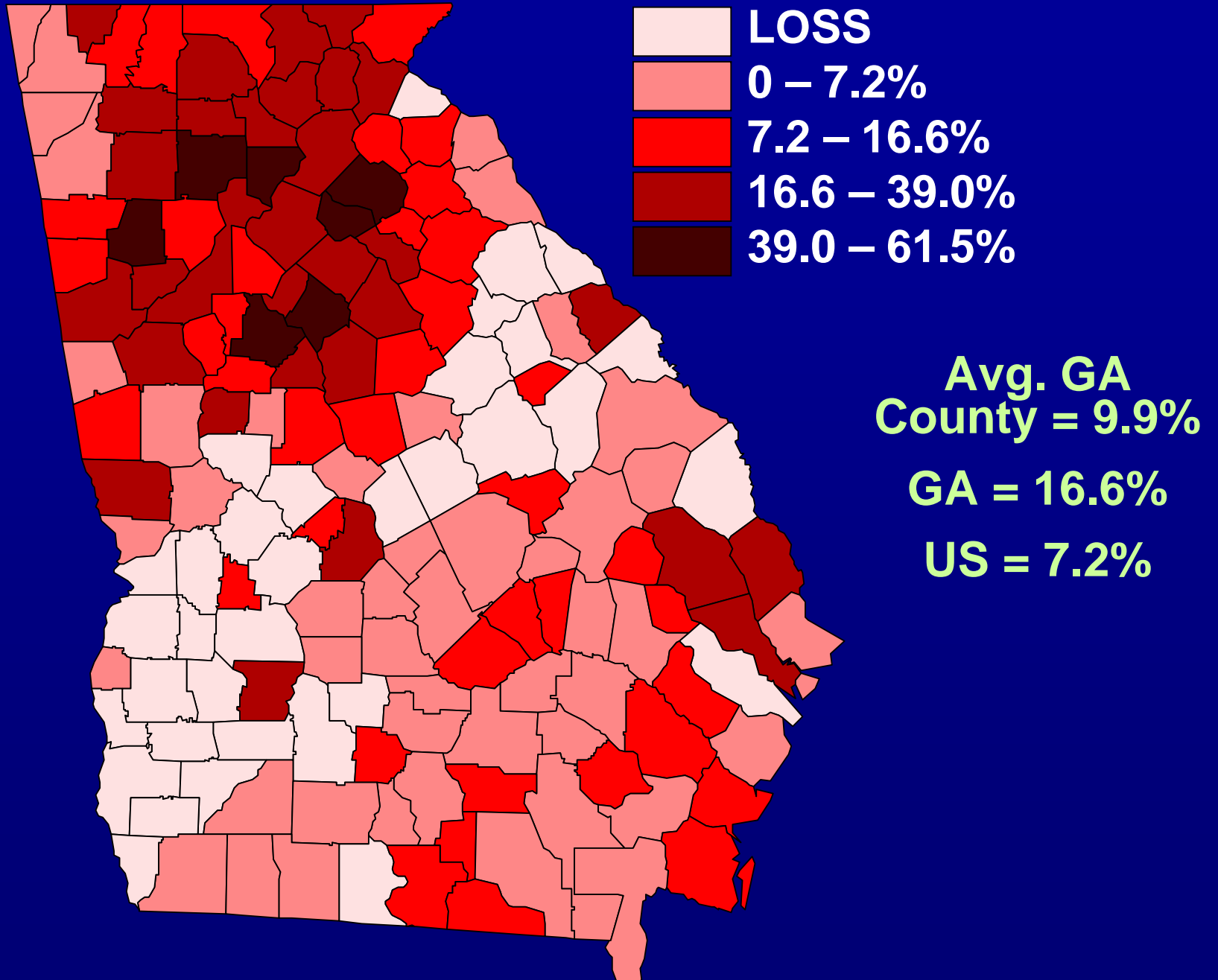

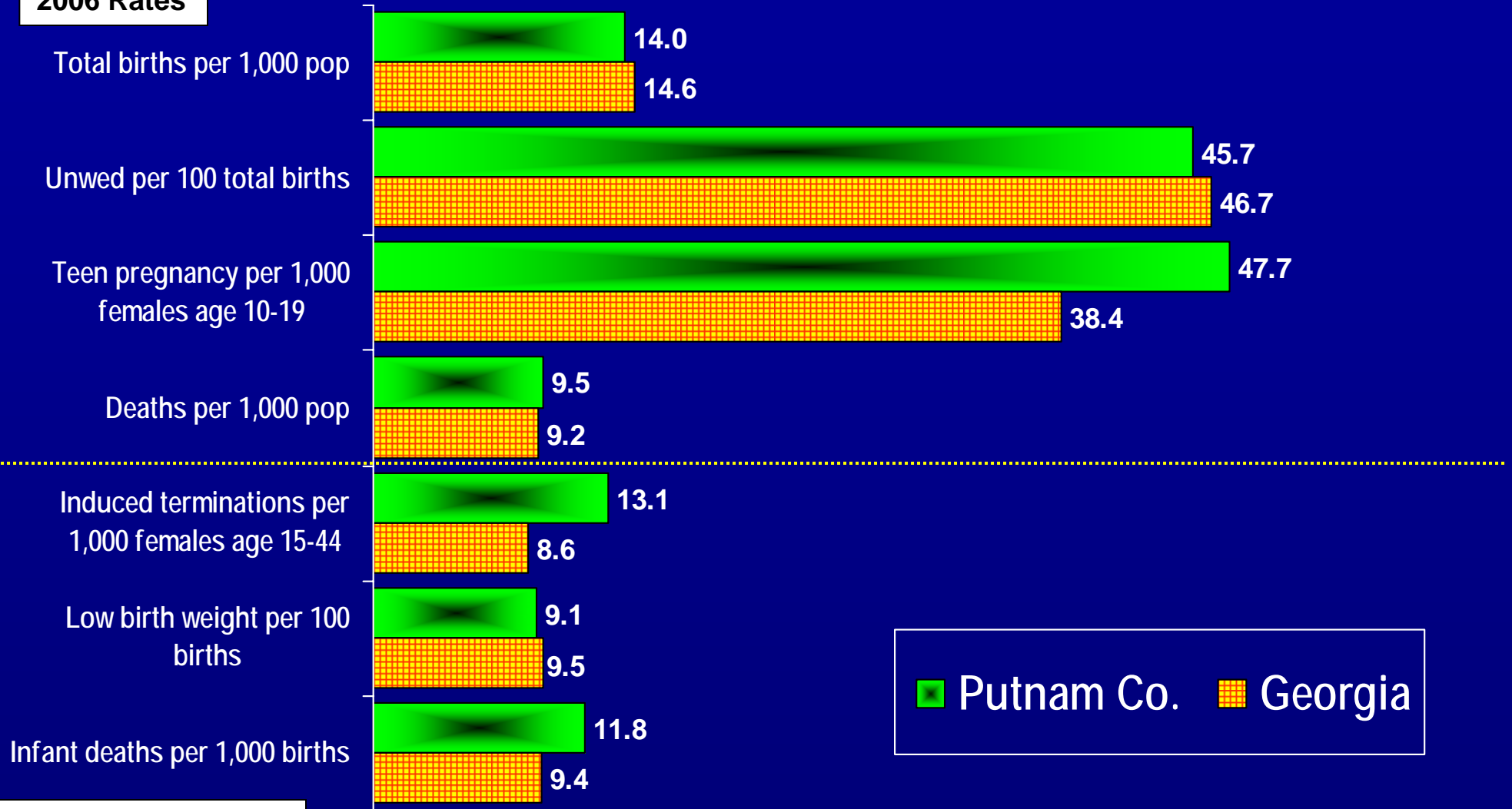

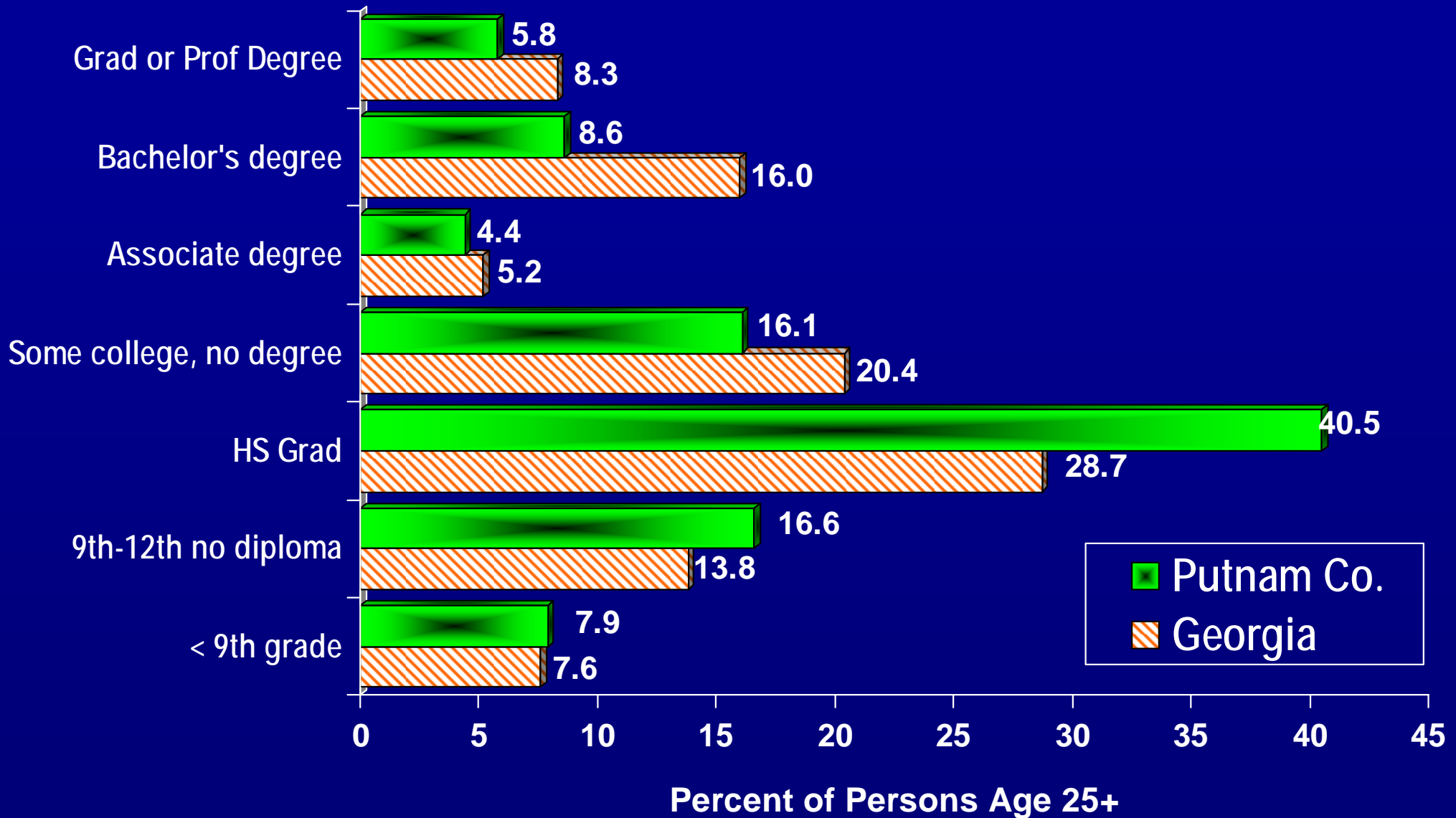

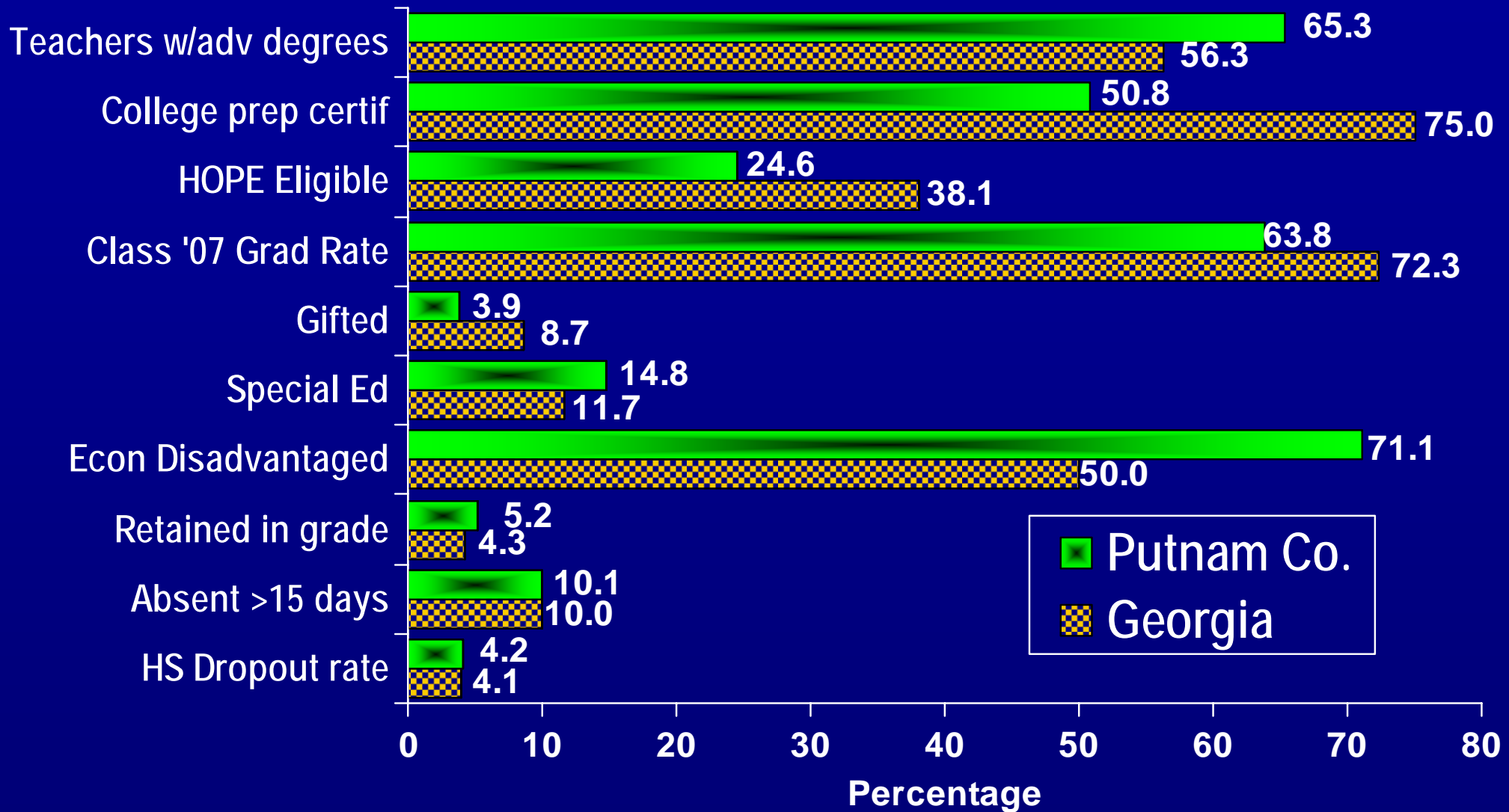

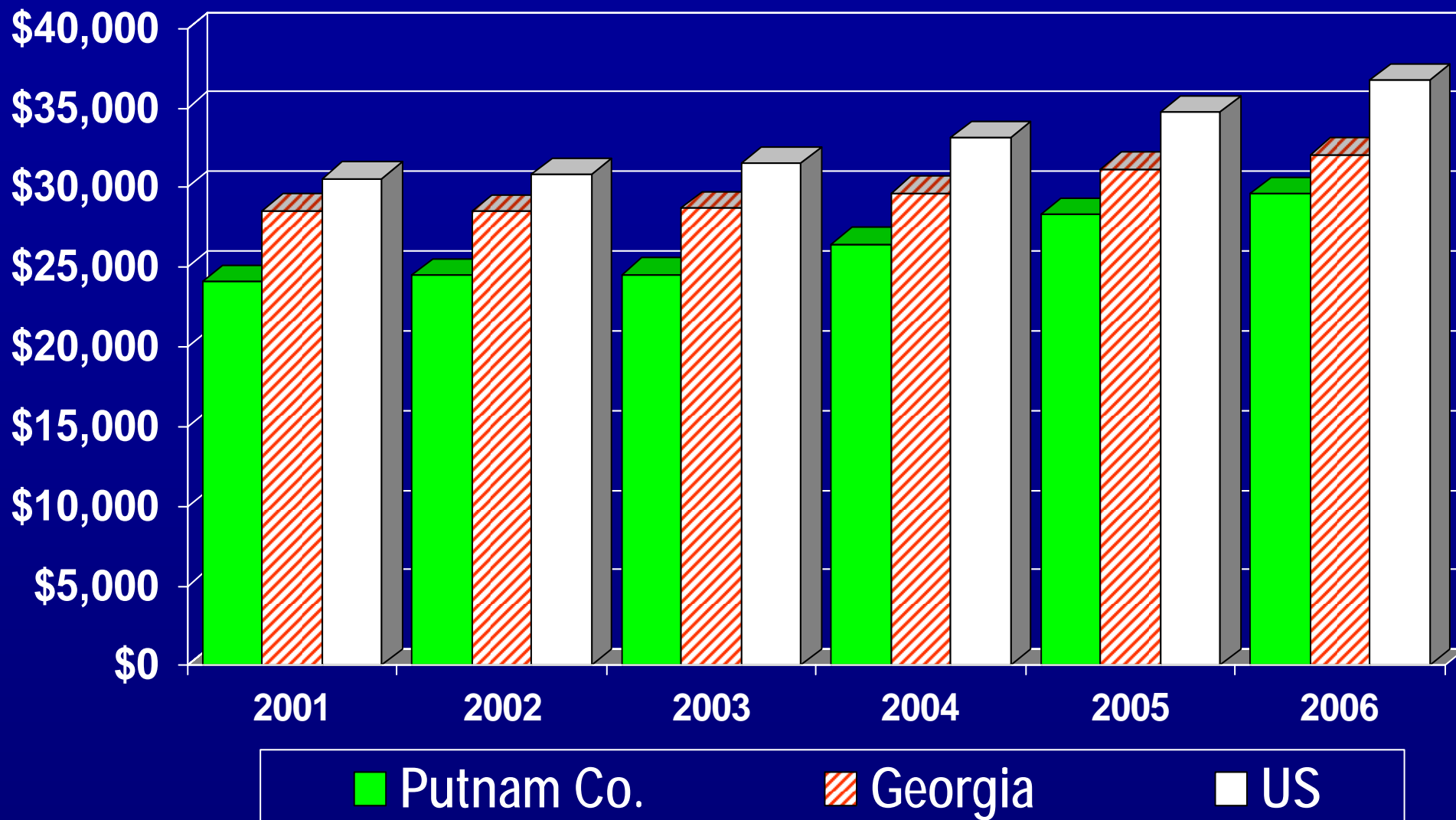

Per Capita Income: 2001-2006

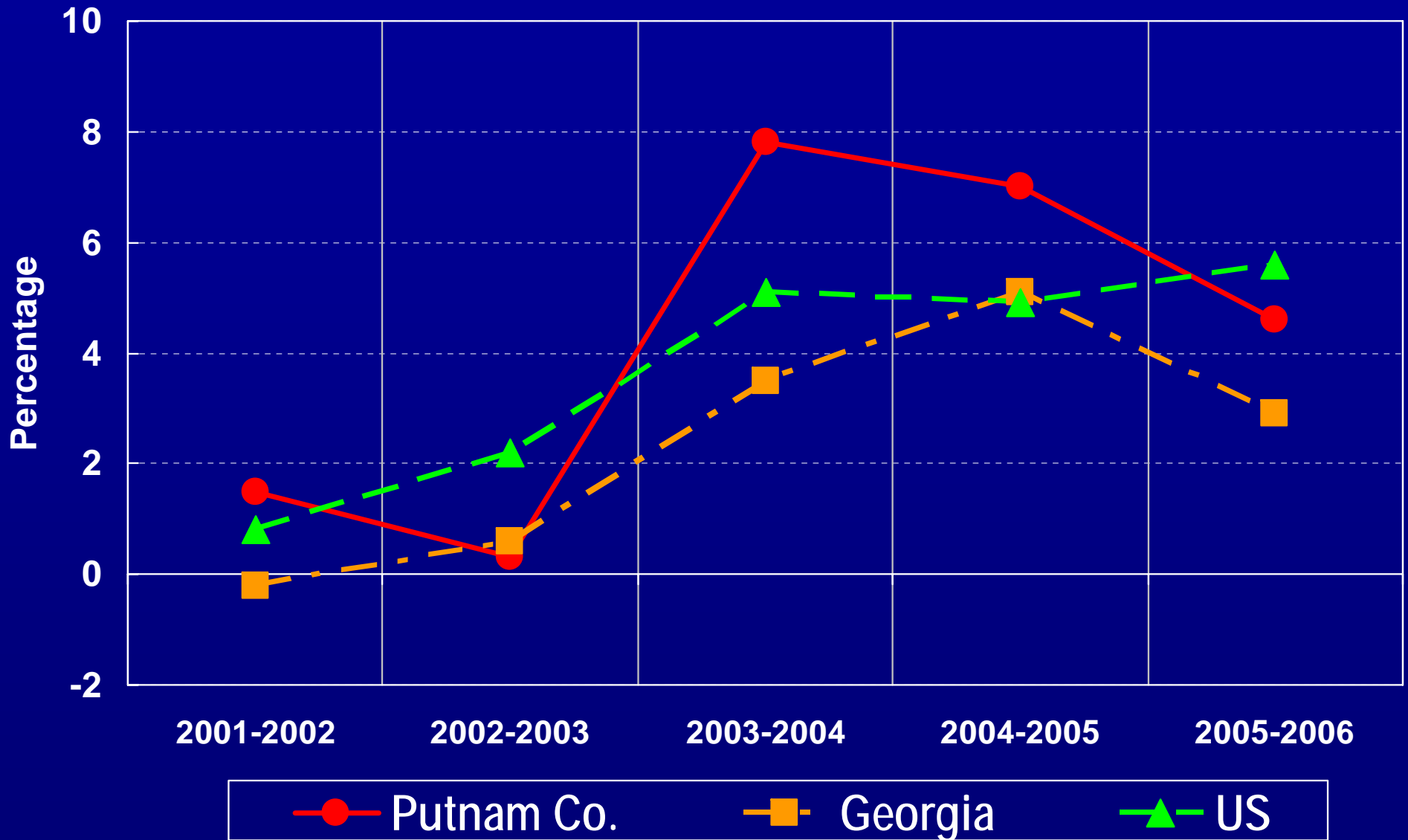

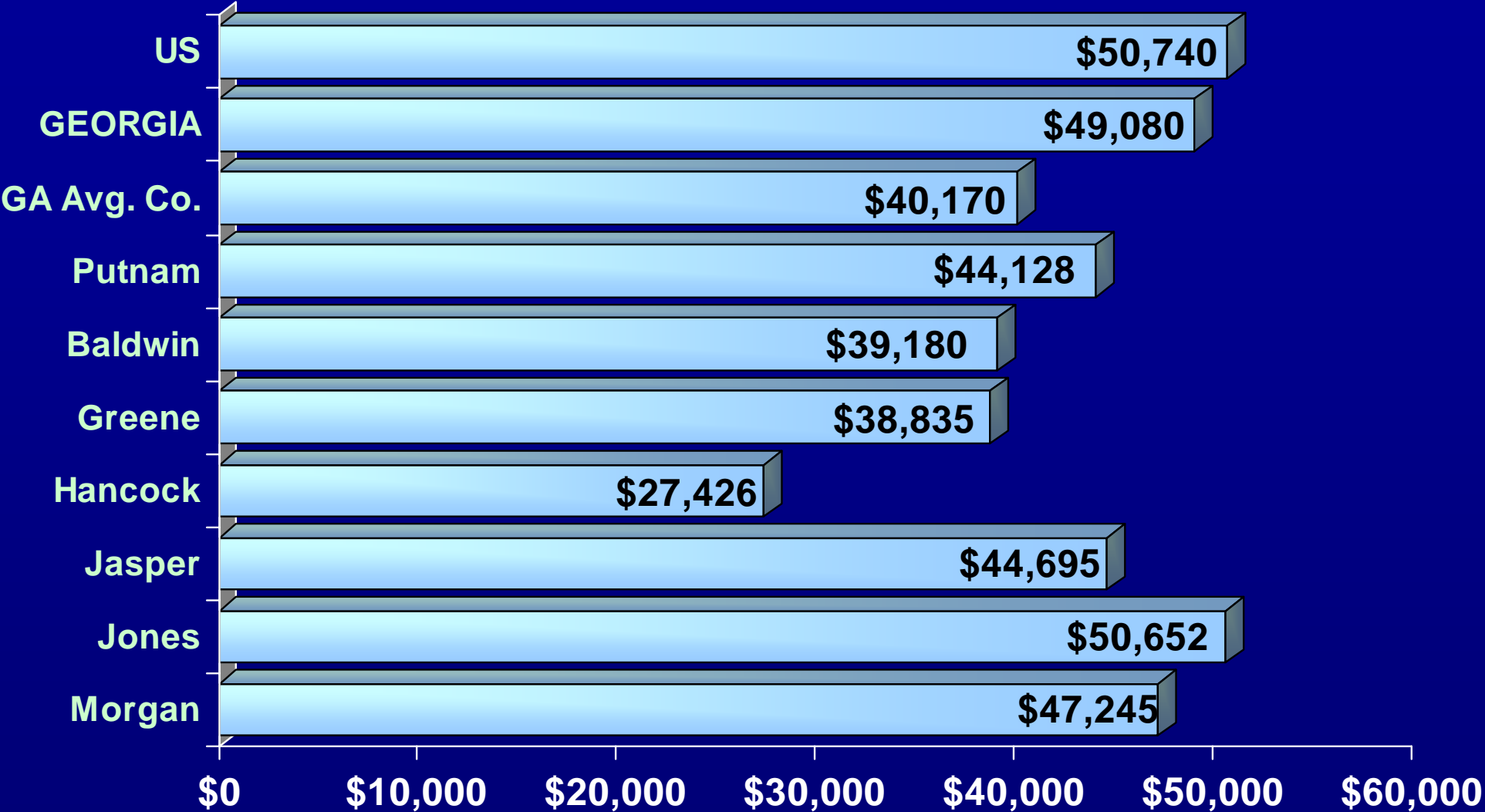

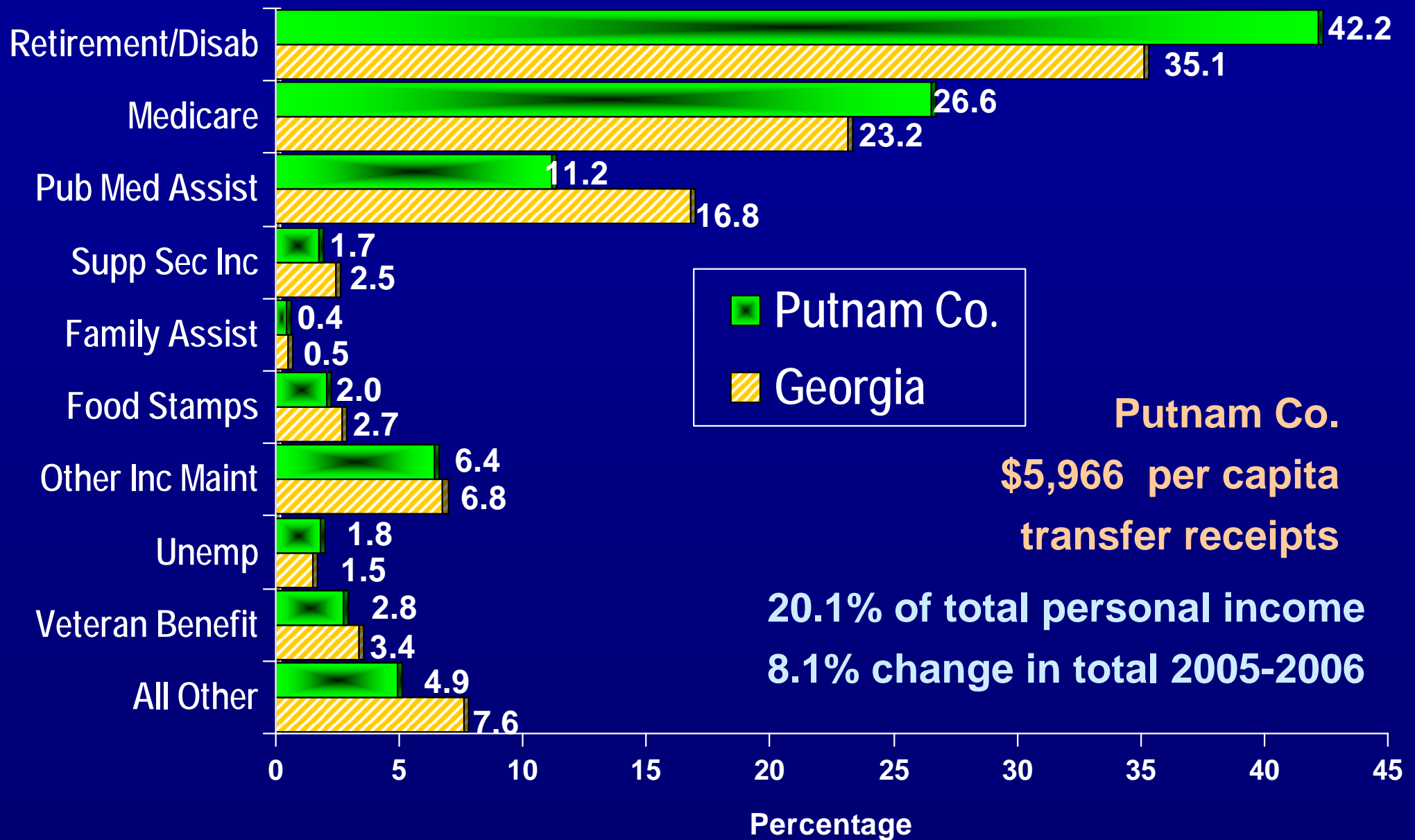
2007 Model-Based Estimates

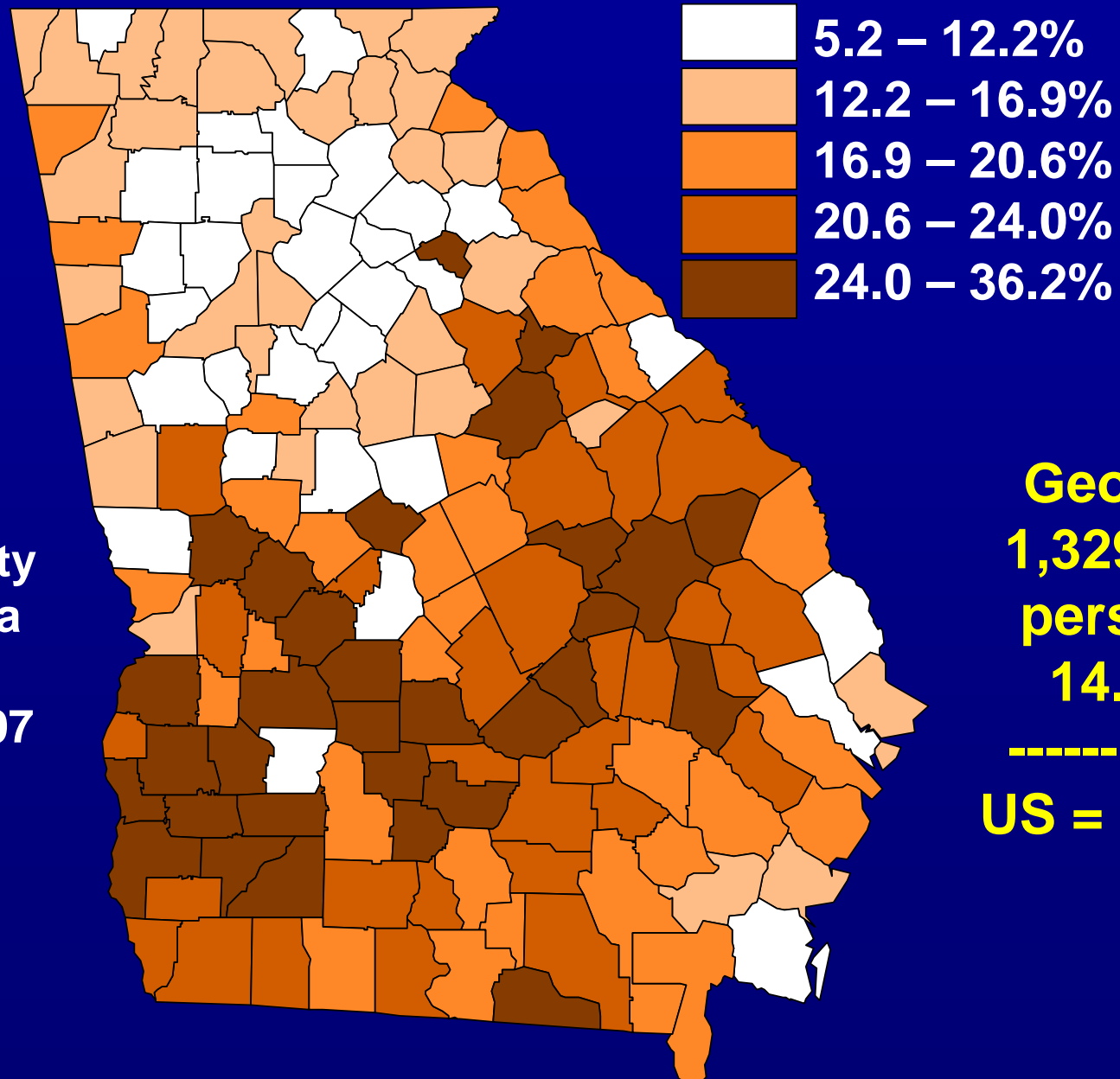

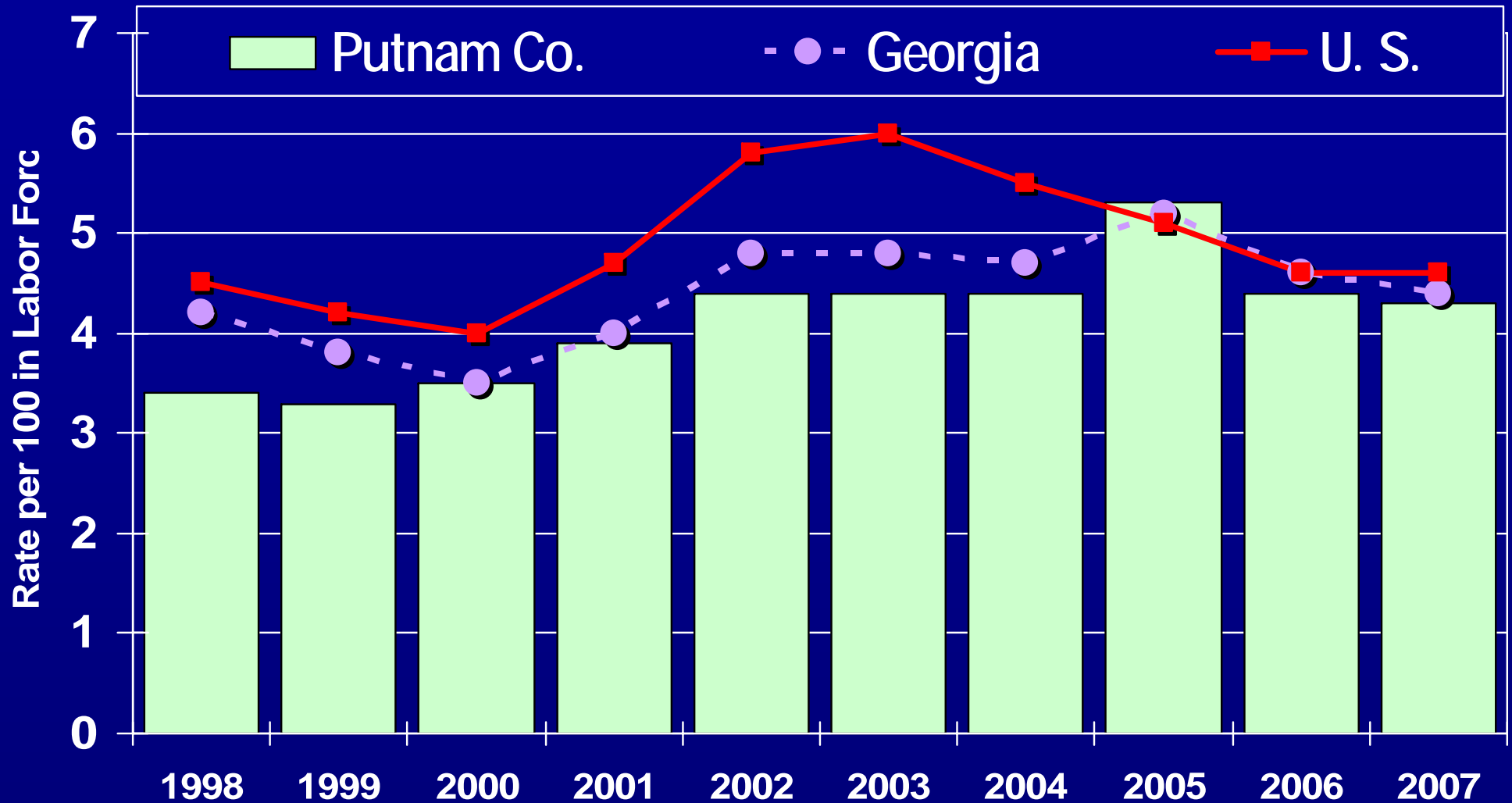

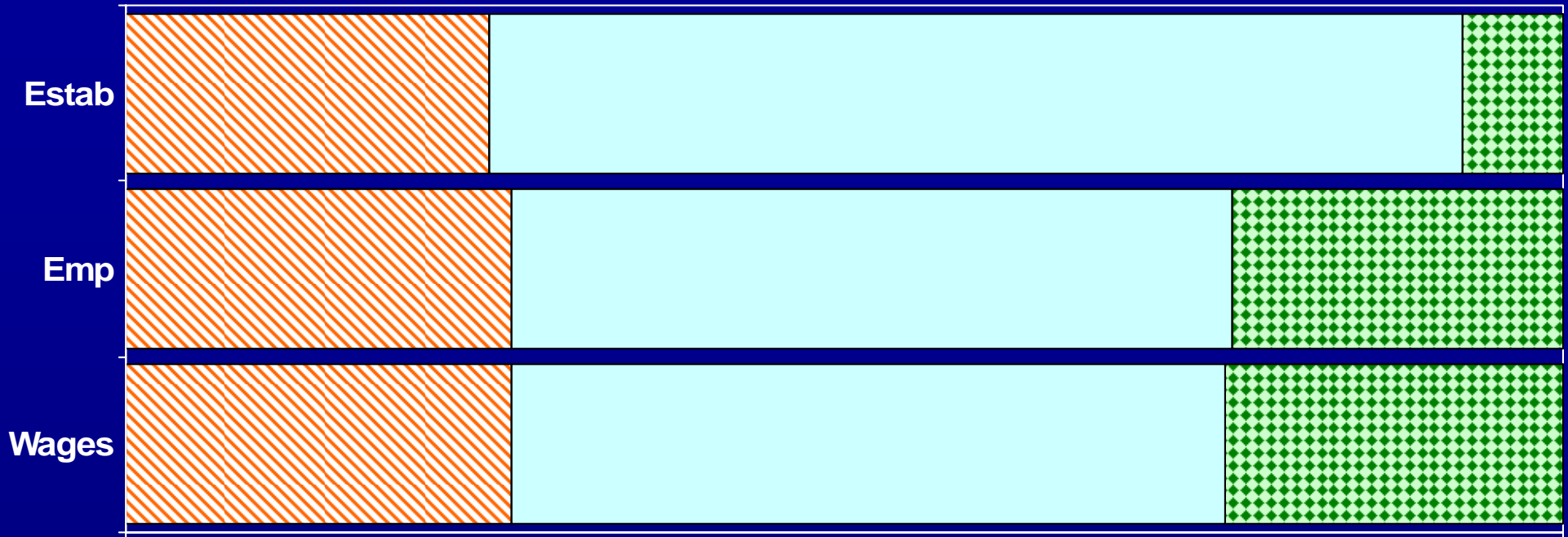

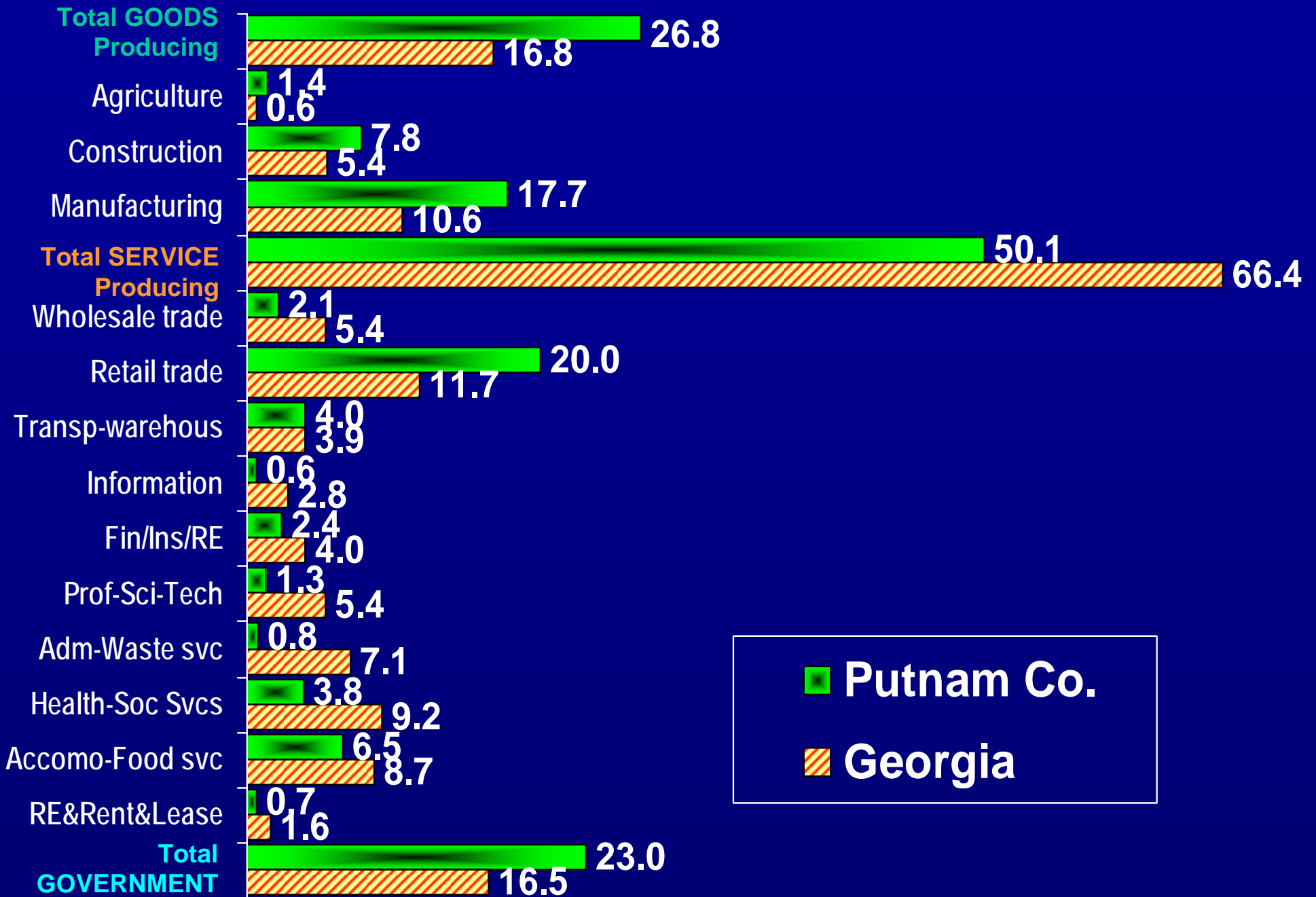

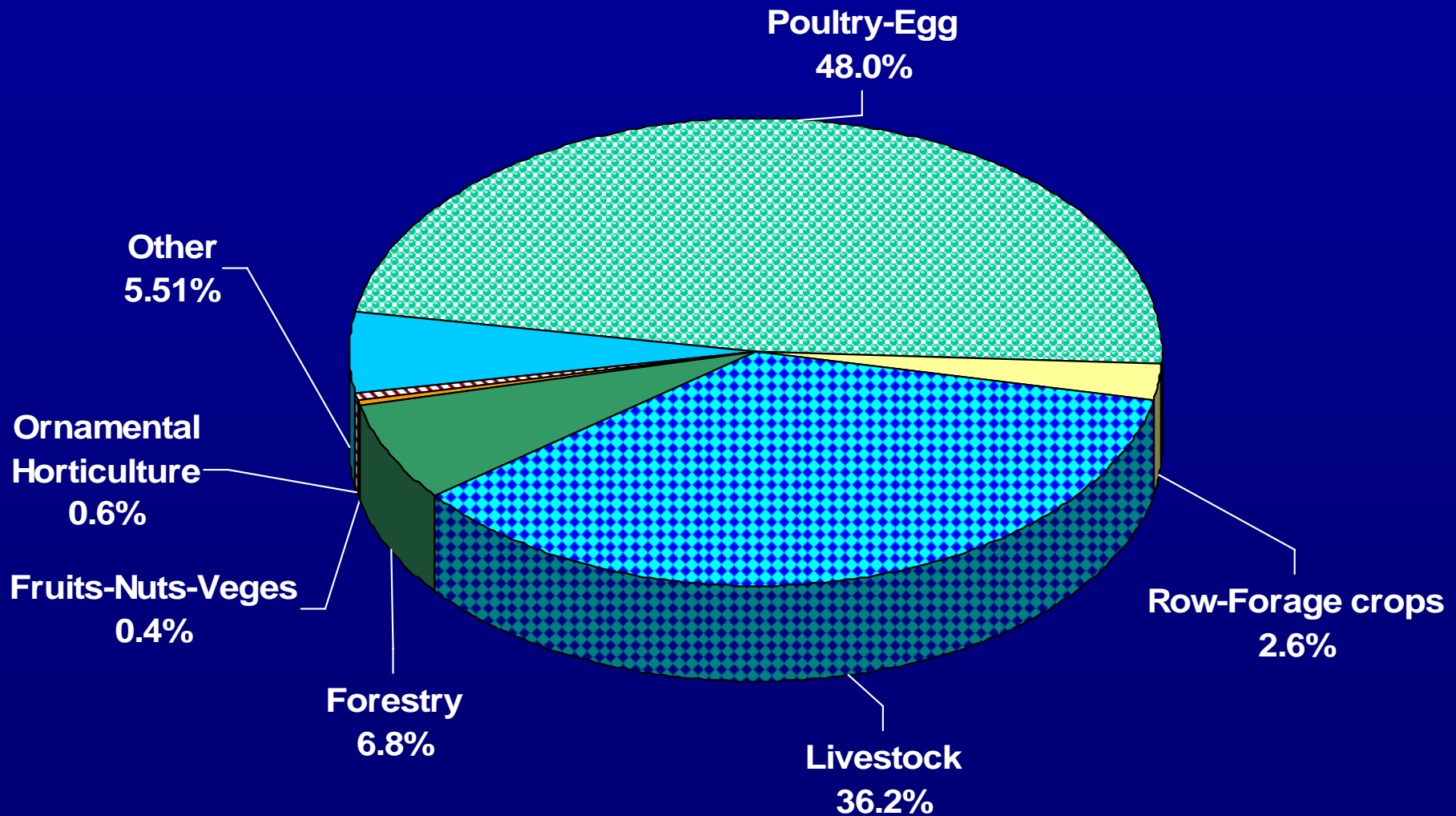
Selected Employment Comparisons by Industry: 2007

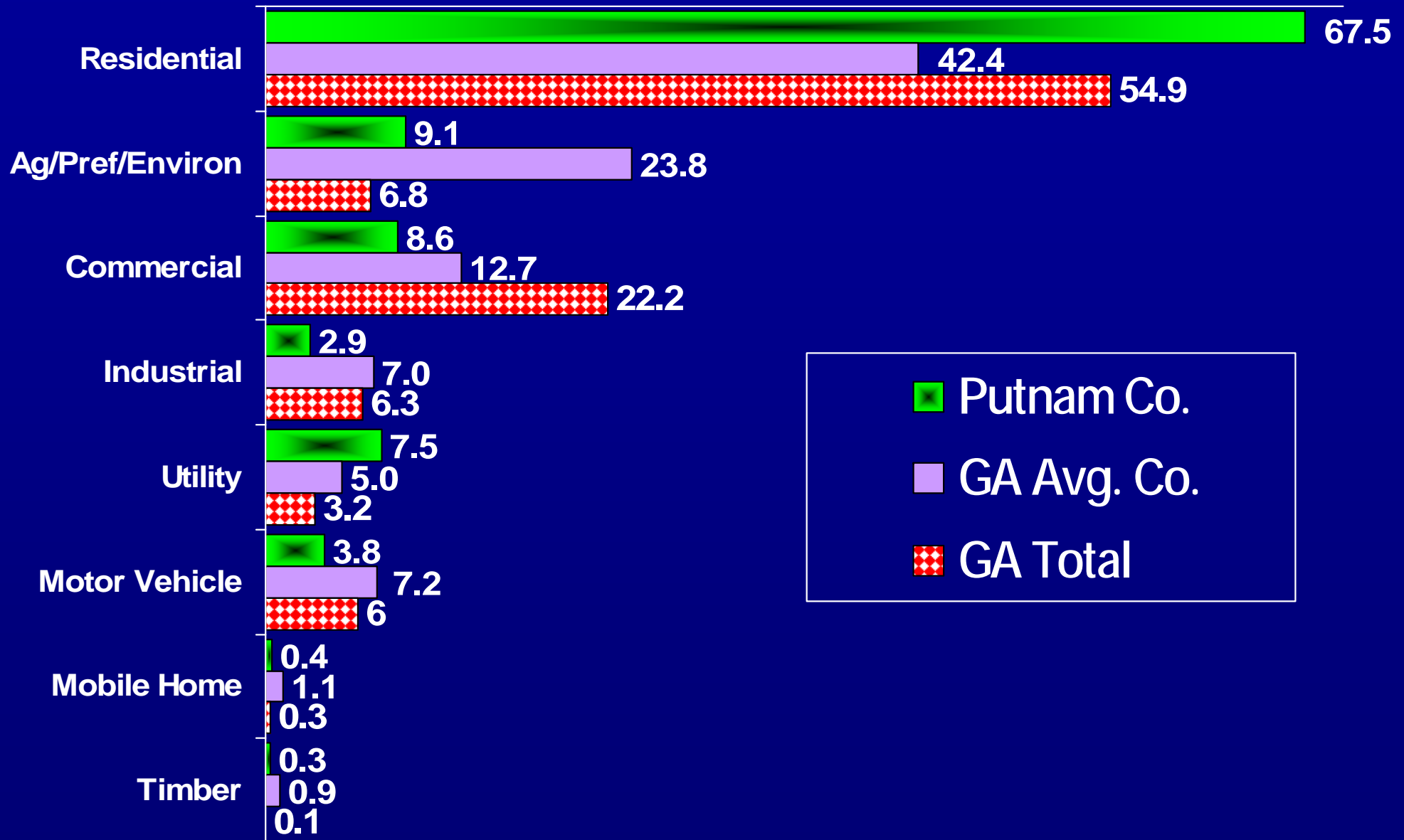
Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group: 2007

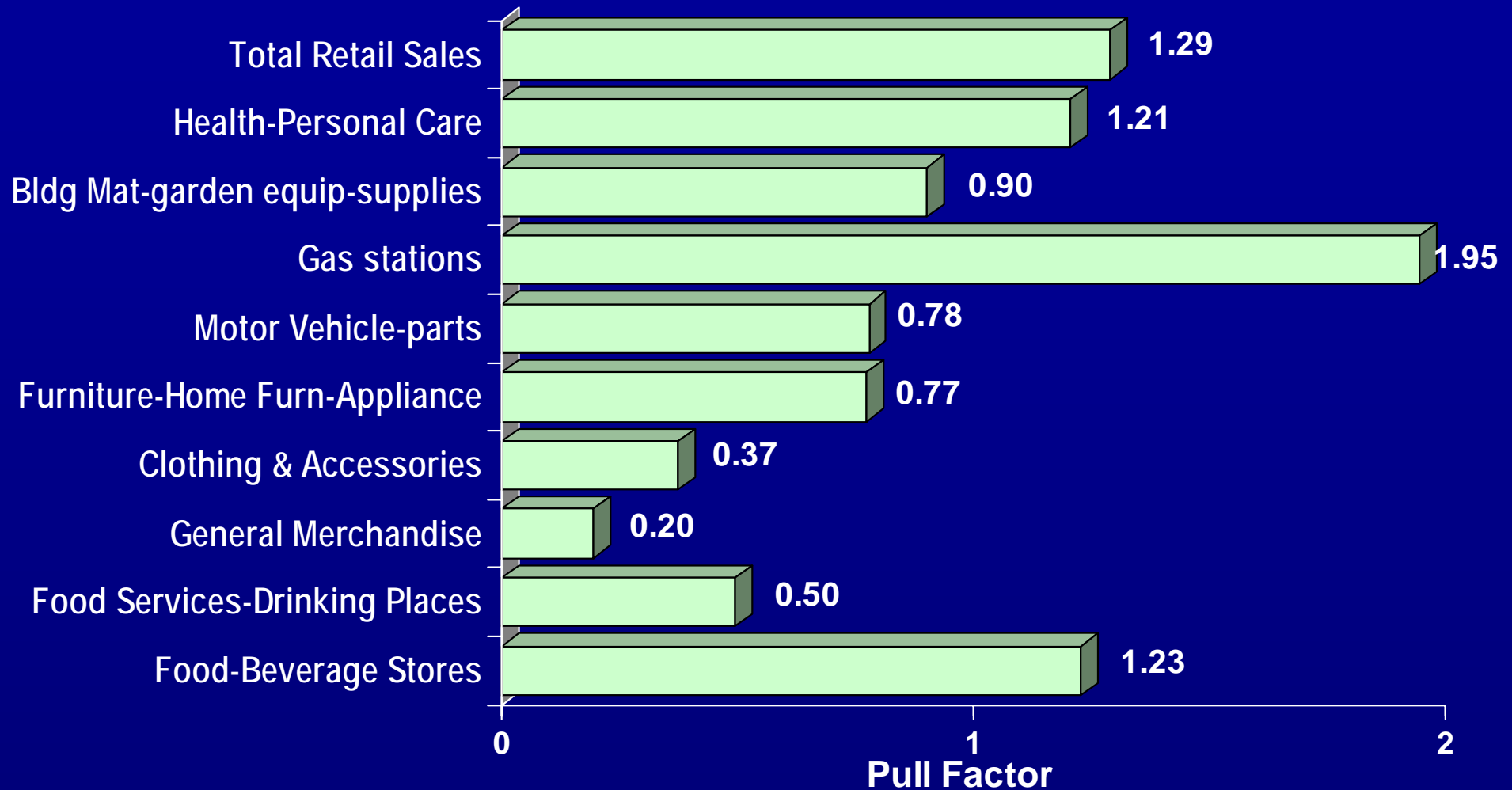

Retail Sales Analysis: 2007

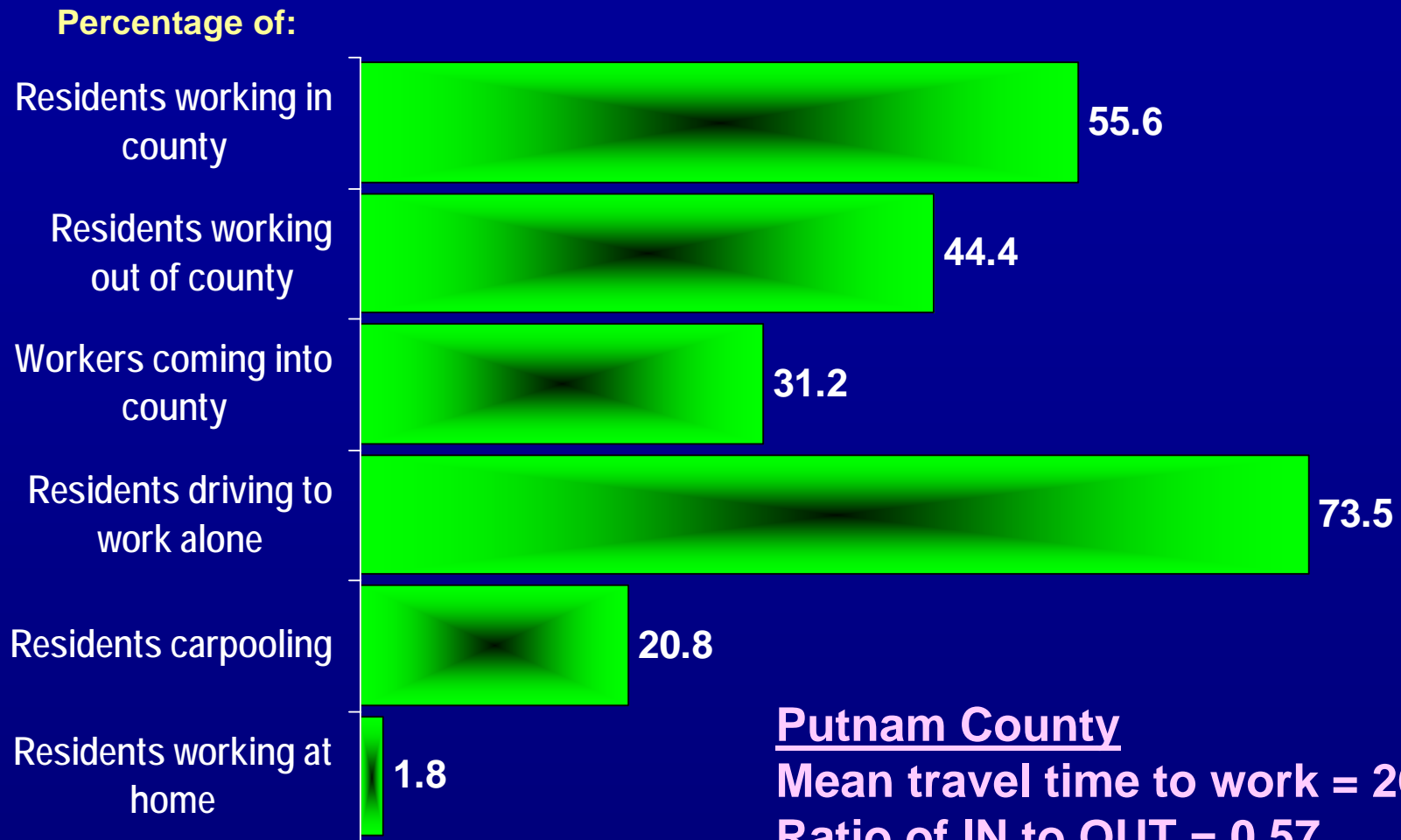
Putnam Co. Total Retail Sales = \$249,269,000

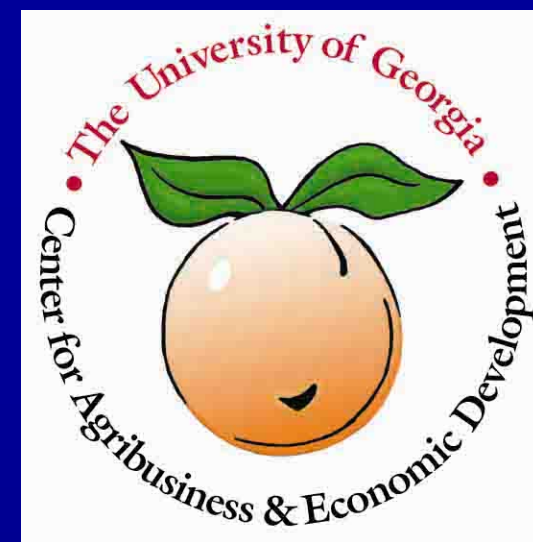
